- H. Release or Disclosure of Records to Others
- 3. Release of Directory Information
- ...Permission of the parent or eligible student is not required for the release of information that is designated as directory information by the board, provided that the parent or eligible student has been given proper notice and an opportunity to opt out. (See policy 1310/4002, Parental Involvement.)
 - a. The board designates the following student record information as directory information:
 - (1) name;
 - (2) address;
 - (3) telephone listing;
 - (4) electronic mail address...
 - Minimal opportunities for gaining information to contact other parents.

 - a clear and transparent procedure for when someone gets sick and tests positive that has been at school. That procedure should be communicated to all (staff, students, and families).
 - contact tracing support from Bunc Co DHHS/MAHEC?
 - is there a closure for cleaning and quarantine?
 - will staff have the ability to be tested for free?
