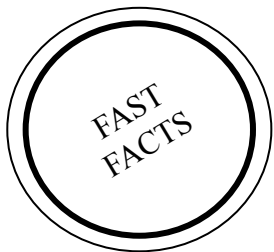

End of Year (EOY) Exams

The EOC or NCFE (9-12) will be  of the final grade!



- Grades 3-4: Paper and pencil tests
 - Grades 5-12: Online tests
 - Each test generally takes about two hours to finish.
- Each test must be completed during a single day unless the student has accommodations providing for multiple days
- If you would like to proctor, please contact your child's school.

Students Should

- Rest well the night before the test.
- Eat a nourishing breakfast the morning of the test.
- Be in school and on time the morning of the test.
- Participate in EOY test practice with your teacher and review released test items.
- Listen closely to the teacher's directions during the test.
- Read each test question and response carefully before marking an answer choice.
- Stay calm if there are questions that seem difficult, and mark your best answer.
- Refrain from bringing to the test any electronic device that can be used for communicating, timing, or imaging.

Parents Should

- Ensure your child receives a good night of sleep.
- Contact your child's teachers as often as necessary to discuss their progress.
- Check or review your child's homework, projects, or other school work.
- Ask teachers to suggest activities for you and your child to do at home to help prepare for tests and to improve your child's understanding of school work.
- Talk with your child about school.
- Provide positive feedback by praising your child for what they do well.
- Discuss test taking tips and strategies to relieve test anxiety.
