

DISCRETIONARY ADMISSION OF OUT-OF-DISTRICT STUDENTS

Administrative Procedure:

4130-P

A. REVOCATIONS OF ADMISSION FOR OUT-OF-DISTRICT STUDENTS

Per Board Policy 4130, admission may be revoked at any time during the school year if a student is not in good standing with Asheville City Schools. Good standing is defined as the following:

Academics

- Unsatisfactory progress in any grading period may place a student in jeopardy of not being in good standing for academics

Satisfactory Attendance

- Per Board Policy 4400, a maximum of 18 absences

Timely Arrival/Dismissal Each Day

- Per Board Policy 4400, a maximum of 18 tardies or early dismissals

Behavior

- Behaviors resulting in a consequence of in school or out of school suspension may place a student in jeopardy of not being in good standing for behavior

B. RENEWAL OF ADMISSION FOR OUT-OF-DISTRICT STUDENTS

Per board policy 4130, Out-of-District students must submit an Asheville City Schools Application yearly in order to continue with Asheville City Schools. To be considered for continued enrollment students must be in good standing. Good standing is defined as the following:

Academics

- Unsatisfactory progress in any grading period may place a student in jeopardy of not being in good standing for academics

Satisfactory Attendance

- Per Board Policy 4400, a maximum of 18 absences

Timely Arrival/Dismissal Each Day

- Per Board Policy 4400, a maximum of 18 tardies or early dismissals

Behavior

- Behaviors resulting in a consequence of in school or out of school suspension may place a student in jeopardy of not being in good standing for behavior
